OVERVIEW

THE FINE & RARE COLLECTION

The Macallan distillery, one of the first licensed distilleries in Scotland, has remained fundamentally unchanged for nearly 200 years, still located along the magnificent River Spey where it was founded. The Macallan has established its renown as the “peerless spirit” due to a strong tradition of unwavering devotion to quality. It is sought after in the finest hotels, bars and restaurants around the world and savored by discerning whisky lovers who recognize it as the world’s most precious whisky.

The Macallan Fine & Rare Collection represents the very best of The Macallan’s oldest maturing stock and the greatest range of vintage single malt whisky ever released. Every year, the range is augmented by the introduction of a new vintage release. The full collection of vintages embodies a liquid history of The Macallan, offering insights into the aroma and flavors characteristic of this great single malt, stretching back to the earliest release distilled in 1926. Over the years, the Fine & Rare range has underpinned The Macallan as the world’s most valuable and collectable single malt whisky, dominating auctions around the world and setting world record prices, both at auction and private sale. Only a small number of bottles are released each year.

Page Reference Guide

A quick page reference Guide to Vintage Macallan

CASK TYPE | This describes the type and size in which the whisky slept during its maturation. A sherry butt can hold 500 bulk liters of spirit while a sherry hogshead, half its size, can hold 250. This whisky is traditionally filled to cask at 63.4% alcohol by volume (abv).

CASK NO. | The numbered cask from which the whisky was drawn.

.....

NOSE | This describes the prominent aromas that can be identified when one smells the whisky. Some 70% of flavor is down to its smell/nose.

.....

PALATE | This describes the flavors that are recognized in the mouth when drinking whisky.

.....

FINISH | This describes the way the whisky feels in the mouth and how long the sensation lingers.

.....

STRENGTH | The strength of whisky is measured by the % of alcohol relative to water or alcohol by volume (abv).

FLAVOR PROFILE | The Spider Diagram graphically illustrates the flavors, and their respective intensity, that are prevalent within the whisky, on a scale of 0 (flavor is not present) to 5 (dominant within the whisky). This is our sensory fingerprint.

COLOR | The visual color of the whisky is described in terms of various wood species.

.....

TINT | The tint value is derived from shining beam of light through the whisky to measure color scientifically.

.....

YEAR BOTTLED | The date the whisky was originally bottled from cask.

.....

AGE OF WHISKY | The age of the whisky when bottled from cask.

.....

TOTAL OUTTURN | This is the total amount of whisky available, expressed in 750ml bottle equivalents (Bottle Eq.).

1937 | During 1937 there were a few major technological breakthroughs. Charlie Chaplin's first "talkie" movie, *Modern Times*, was released. Amelia Earhart, the first woman to fly across the Atlantic and the first person to fly solo from Hawaii to California, was presumed killed when her aircraft disappeared mysteriously over the Pacific.

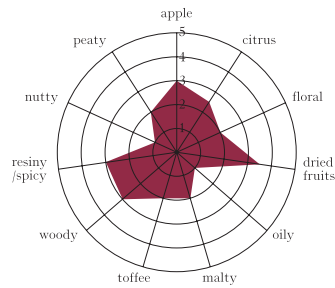

1937 | George Gershwin died at age 38. Gershwin was most famous for composing numerous songs and Broadway shows, but he also enjoyed parallel careers as pianist and composer in the orchestral and theatrical genres. Hollywood released his musical *Shall We Dance*, starring Fred Astaire and Ginger Rogers, and featuring the song "Let's Call The Whole Thing Off."

NOSE

Apple fruits with floral notes balanced with citrus orange and clear esters (pear drops). Hints of nuttiness add complexity.

PALATE

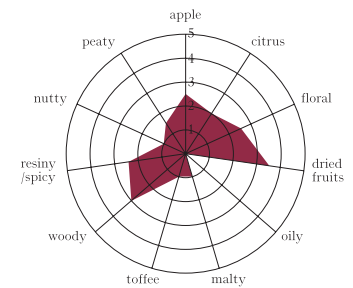
Light citrus fruit and spices balanced with peat reck (smoke), good dried fruits and aged wood.

FINISH

Fruits and wood with lingering peat smoke – rich, round, smooth and long. A little dryness is evident in this bottling.

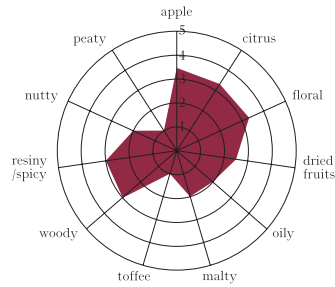

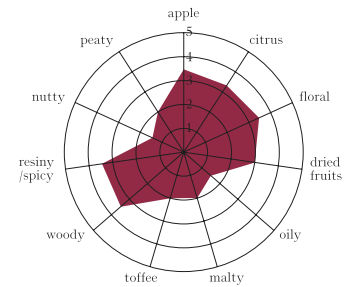

Heavy burnt peat dominates the nose with dried fruits and vanilla toffee notes breaking through on second nosing. Some hints of lighter and citrus fruits with a late floral nose.

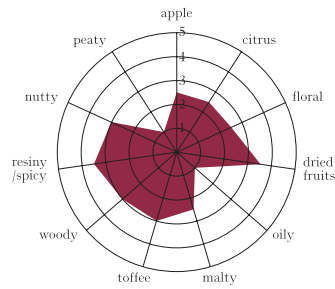

Pabst of the Bantam Car Company, Butler, Pennsylvania, produced a four-wheel drive vehicle which became famous as the Jeep. It was given its name by its military designation, G.P. (General Purpose).

The Space Shuttle Discovery placed the Hubble Space Telescope into orbit. The US and the Soviet Union agreed to end production of chemical weapons and to destroy most of their stockpiles of chemical weapons. The Motion Picture Association of America replaced its X rating with a new NC-17 rating. Washington National Cathedral was completed after 83 years of construction.

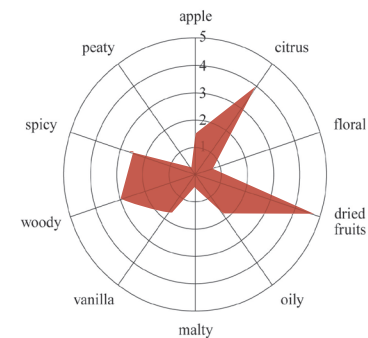
